An enforceable human right to a healthy environment



The substantive part:

- Clean air
- A safe climate
- Access to safe water and adequate sanitation
- Healthy and sustainably produced food
- Non-toxic environments in which to live, work, study and play
- **Healthy biodiversity** and ecosystems



Guarantee the highest standards for the six features

- > Define to the highest standards
- > Enforce against public bodies and polluters
- Oblige duty bearers to comply
- Courts to apply environmental principles
- Provide effective remedies

The procedural part:

- **Access to information**
- Participation in decision making
- Access to justice



Recommendations

Reform legal expenses so that it is affordable for all of us to uphold environmental laws in a court or tribunal

- > Reform legal aid
- Replace loser pays rule with qualified one way costs shifting
- > Remove court fees

Key legislative processes in 2022/3

- **Legal Aid Reform Bill**
- Consultation on court fees

Recommendations

Create a specialist environmental court or tribunal which is affordable and accessible for everyone, fair, timely and effective

- > An institutional purpose to promote access to justice
- > Ability to appoint judges and experts
- Comprehensive iurisdiction
- Powers to set rules and procedures
- > Act as a one-stop shop
